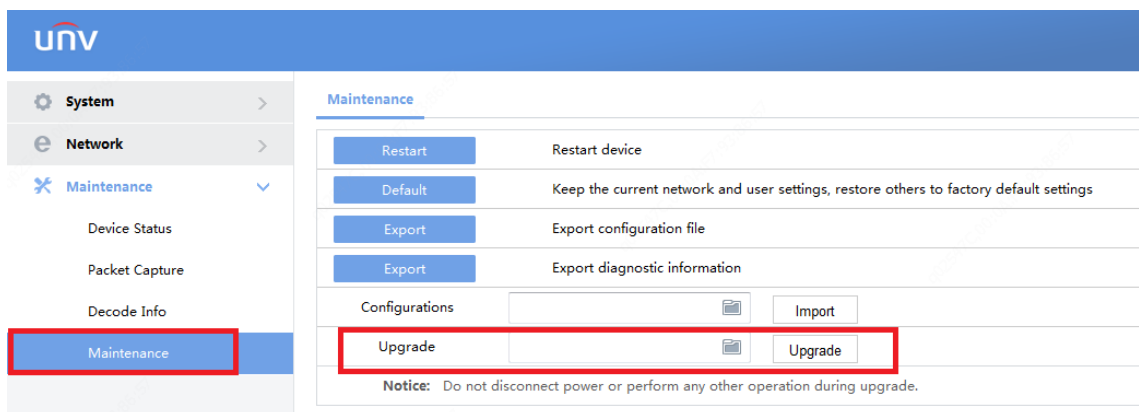

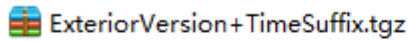

Access the device's Web interface and import Package (ExteriorVersion+TimeSuffix) to upgrade.

- (1) Open IE, enter the device's IP address in the address bar to open the login page.
- (2) Log in with username/password (admin/123456).
- (3) Click **Maintenance>Maintenance**.
- (4) Click the **Browse** button, select Package of the new version, and then click **Upgrade** to start upgrade.



**Caution**

- Do NOT disconnect power or perform any other operation during upgrade.
 - No success message will be displayed when upgrade is finished, but the device will restart automatically.
 - **Configurations and logs are saved automatically when you upgrade in this way.**
